## An Introduction to Islamic Geometric Pattern and Design

The beauty of Islamic geometric design, and the breathtaking skill of the craftsmen who created them, are admired the world over. In this presentation, Eric Broug will show some of the masterpieces of this design tradition, both in art and architecture. From the Alhambra to Fatehpur Sikri, from Isfahan to Baghdad, From Marrakech to Samarkand, you will learn of the immense skill of the craftsmen in designing these geometric compositions.

Eric Broug has been studying Islamic geometric design for over 25 years. He has written two popular books on the subject. His most recent book, Islamic Geometric Design was published in November 2013. He received his Masters degree in the History of Islamic Art and Architecture from London's School of Oriental and African Studies (SOAS). He now runs Broug Ateliers Ltd, a design and educational company specialising in Islamic geometric design. His books have been translated into five languages, including Farsi and Turkish.
